North Marine provides marina evacuation assistance in the Port of Cairns in the event of forecasted severe weather, tropical cyclones and Port closures directed by the Regional Harbour Master.

Upon the directive to evacuate Cairns Marlin Marina or other areas of the Port, NM is engaged to re-locate vessels to their designated area of shelter. NM workboats and crew tow unmanned vessels and assist those under power to their designated area of shelter. Once permitted, vessels are re-berthed in their usual location. Additionally, in preparation for severe weather, North Marine inspects/maintains existing moorings and installs cyclone-rated boat moorings.

Capabilities


- Emergency response mobilisation
