

## **Scope of work**

North Marine provides a tug assist charter to a 180-meter, 25,000 gross-ton bulk carrier, the 'M.V. Funing' through the Torres Strait.

North Marine's tugboat 'Gulf Explorer' mobilised to the Torres Strait from the Port of Cairns, QLD. She took up the stern tow position as the bulk carrier's tug escort, while another tug took the forward tow position. The charter involved transiting through the narrow Prince of Wales Channel on the Great Barrier Reef, commencing at Bligh Entrance, near Bramble Cay. The tug's role was to hold the ship straight, limiting yawning during the narrow reef ocean crossing.
