

## Scope of work

Client: Quicksilver Group - Great Adventures

January 2020

North Marine's tug boats and commercial divers are contracted to disconnect and tow Quicksilver's pontoon for routine maintenance.

Annually, Quicksilver Group engage North Marine to disconnect, tow and re-install the tourist attraction. The 'Great Adventures Pontoon' leaves the Great Barrier Reef for a 37 nautical mile tow to Cairns Port for maintenance and refurbishment. NM divers disconnect and reconnect the pontoon from its moored reef location as required - while the NM tugboat tows the craft to/from the Port of Cairns. It is skilfully maneuvered back into place on the GBR upon completion of each refit. North Marine charter tugboat 'Gulf Explorer' is utilised.
