

## Scope of work

June 2023

Client: Queensland Police Service - QLD Government

North Marine was engaged to install an additional 2 UMD pontoons to the existing wharf system at MSQ Marine Operations Base in Cairns.

Having installed the adjoining modular pontoons in 2022 for TAFE Qld, North Marine used the same methodology for this project, which also ran seamlessly & was completed in 1 day. NM used stainless steel dyno-bolts to affix the anchors. Once the anchors were attached to the wharf, NM's fleet truck & crane lowered the floating pontoons into position & secured them in place. Cleats and fenders were then fixed to the new structures. Concrete drilling was used to attach pole anchors to the main wharf. An onsite Officer In Charge expressed high satisfaction with the expertise of NM staff.
