



TECHNICAL SUPPORT TO BULK CARRIER - EMERGENCY LAUNCH

► Scope of work

September 2020

Client: Marine Engineering Solutions as ships agent for The Shipping Corporation of India Ltd.

North Marine mobilised to provide urgent technical support to a 44,000-ton international bulk carrier, whose anchor chain tangled.

Crew launched by helicopter from the Port of Mackay to the bulk carrier, which was on anchorage at Hay Point. The vessel had been rendered immobile due to a knot in the substantial 92mm chain, which was supporting a 7-ton anchor. After the anchor and chain's weight were secure, North Marine technicians used oxy-acetylene tools to cut the entanglement and install a kenter linking shackle.

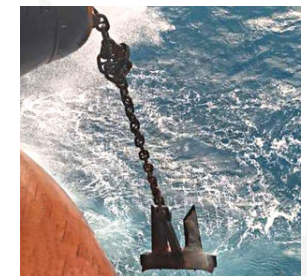
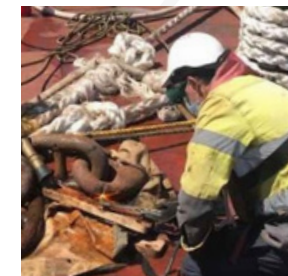
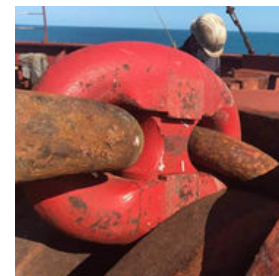
