

OFFSHORE RE-SUPPLY CHARTER BUREAU OF METEOROLOGY

► Scope of work

Client: Bureau of Meteorology (BOM)

2014 - Current: Ongoing

North Marine has performed the offshore re-supply voyage for the remote weather station at Willis Island since 2014, for BOM

The bi-annual resupply voyage includes a changeover of BOM staff, freight, food, equipment and fuel to the Bureau's offshore facility 450km east of Cairns. Utilising charter vessel Gulf Explorer, an accompanying passenger vessel and multiple tender boats. These logistically challenging voyages include extensive planning with BOM and customs as well as performance reporting, biosecurity and quarantine compliance. The charter takes approx 9 days.

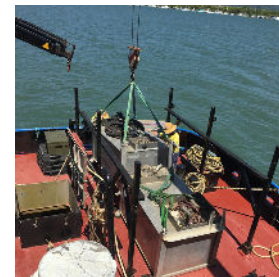
