

Scope of work

In August 2025, North Marine was engaged by Marine Structures to support cargo transport, pile removal, and pontoon installation at Bloomfield River, Far North Queensland.

The project involved transporting 69 tonnes of cargo from North Wharf in Cairns to Bloomfield River on the dumb barge WBIV, towed by Pacific Ranger. WBIV remained onsite for three weeks to support operations. North Marine also provided specialised dive support for the removal of two partially submerged piles within Bloomfield River, carried out by an ADAS-certified dive team operating from Sea Horse within a croc cage, with the landing craft Reef Safari assisting in shallow-water access and equipment transport.

Outcome

North Marine safely delivered all cargo, including piles, pontoon, and gangways, into Bloomfield River and supported on-site construction. Two submerged piles were removed by divers under strict safety protocols. The project was completed on schedule with full logistical, dive, and fleet support provided.
