




















Supporting People, Projects and the Planet

At North Marine, sustainability shapes everything we do.

As a family-owned and locally operated marine services company in Cairns, our mission is to deliver safe, practical, and sustainable solutions that protect the environment, support local communities, and strengthen regional capability.

Environmental Responsibility

North Marine was founded on a commitment to safeguard the Great Barrier Reef, starting with the design and installation of reef-friendly mooring systems that protect coral from anchor damage. This principle remains central to our operations today.

Across our fleet and projects, we actively reduce our environmental footprint by:

- Preventative Maintenance: Ensuring vessels and equipment are serviced proactively to maximise efficiency, reduce emissions, and prevent leaks or breakdowns.
- Local Sourcing: Using local suppliers for parts, provisions, and catering to cut down on freight-related emissions and strengthen the regional economy.
- Sustainable Operations: Implementing strict onboard waste management protocols, using biodegradable and non-toxic products where possible, and minimising pollutants across all activities.
- Fuel Efficiency: Planning logistics carefully to optimise voyages and reduce unnecessary idling, lowering overall fuel consumption and carbon output.

We are proud to contribute to reef conservation and environmental outcomes by donating vessels, crew, and commercial diving services to support coral seeding, reef clean-ups, monitoring, and research programs with partners including the Reef Restoration Foundation, Citizens of the Great Barrier Reef, and James Cook University.


