Scope of Work

Between April and May 2026, North Marine completed the salvage and disposal of three derelict vessels across Far North Queensland. The project involved the recovery of Wantok, Reunion and Coopers Boat from remote creek and estuary locations, with all works completed in accordance with MSQ requirements.

Each vessel presented unique access, tidal and environmental challenges, requiring site-specific recovery methodologies and careful planning. North Marine utilised its experienced salvage personnel, specialised equipment and purpose-built vessels to safely recover, remove and dispose of the vessels while minimising impacts on the surrounding environment.

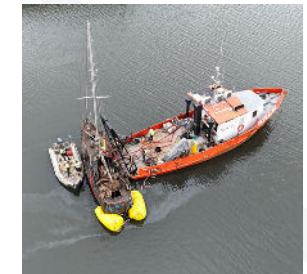
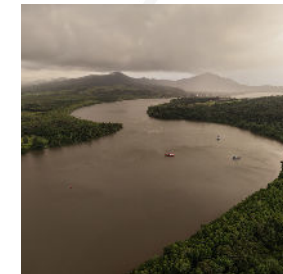
